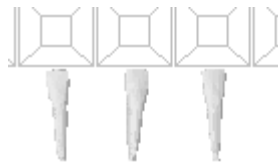

Key to Tx History tab:

- \*\*Look at the Stat (Status column)
  - A, E pink text- existing caries, conditions, restorations (findings)
  - I brown text- in process treatment (fixed, removable usually)
  - C black text – completed treatment
  - S green text – upcoming appts- always appear at bottom of list before planned treatment
  - RC green text- recalls- appear at bottom of list before planned treatment
  - P red text- planned treatments appear at bottom of list- correspond to yellow dots in odontogram
  - Blue text- any of the above, including notes, that are not approved yet
- Tip: Click on Date column heading to sort by date
