Rethinking Education in the COVID Era

Education is changing rapidly in the COVID era. For the first time, LSUSD's Alumni Day program was held remotely. The day featured experts in the field of orofacial pain and lasted almost 7 hours. The event was a team effort from the LSU School of Dentistry Alumni Affairs and the Continuing Dental Education teams.

Live-streaming video conference CE enables dentists and hygienists in rural and small communities to easily and safely attend CE in the comfort and convenience of their homes or offices while minimizing time away from their practices.

According to Bob Leaman, LSUSD's CE Director, "Nationwide during 2020, we have seen the vast majority of continuing dental education courses convert from live, in-person CE courses to live-streaming CE courses; and we have also seen the number of "hands-on" participation courses available decrease significantly. During 2021, I believe we will continue to see a growth in the number of live-streaming video conference courses available as well as growth in the number of "hybrid" CE courses that are part online (either live-streaming or pre-recorded) and part live, in-person."
